**Manawatu District Plan - Roll Over of Designations**

Thank you for your letter dated 4 April 2017.


The NZ Transport Agency, as a requiring authority, holds numerous designations within the Manawatu District. As a requiring authority under Clause 4(1) of the first schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991, the NZ Transport Agency is required to provide written confirmation of whether these designations are to be included in the proposed District Plan, with or without modification.

Accordingly, the Transport Agency confirms that it requires all the designations it currently holds within the Manawatu District to be included in the proposed District Plan. These designations can be rolled over without any modification. The Transport Agency accepts the recommendations for these designations in whole.
