Guide to giving us feedback on a Draft Plan Change to the District Plan



Your feedback is important to ensuring that the District Plan reflects the community's view and gives effect to the requirements under the Resource Management Act (1991).

1. Why provide feedback?

Under the Resource Management Act (1991), the Council may consult with any person during the preparation of a change to the District Plan. If you have views or concerns about a draft plan change, you should give us feedback so your views or concerns on the draft plan change are considered.

You will need to understand what the draft plan change involves and how it might affect you. You might want to ask Council staff to help you understand what is being proposed or seek independent professional advice. Ask yourself what the draft plan change will mean to you. What will be the actual effect on you and the things you want to do on your property? A draft plan change may also affect a wider part of your local community, or region.

2. Discuss your concerns with Council staff

Feel free to discuss your concerns with the Council's policy planning staff. They should be able to tell you why certain provisions were included in the draft plan change. They may also be able to direct you to any other relevant reports or research carried out by the Council.

Consider meeting with other parties which may have similar concerns to you. You are likely to benefit from the opportunity to exchange views.
